**Easement Incentive Act would aid Conservancy efforts**

**R**ep. Chris Collins, R-27, and Rep. Tom Reed, R-23, are co-sponsoring the Conservation Easement Incentive Act (H.R. 2807).

The act would help the Genesee Valley Conservancy work with farm and forest owners to complete conservation projects that protect important farms and forests, while the land remains in private ownership.

Benjamin Gajewski, executive director of the Genesee Valley Conservancy, visited Collins in Washington earlier this spring to discuss the local effects the Act would have on protect-

ing the economic viability of agriculture and natural habitat in the Genesee Valley.

The Conservancy is a nationally accredited conservation organization working to protect the habitat, working lands and open space in the Genesee River watershed. The Conservancy was founded in 1990, and has protected more than 14,400 acres of natural habitat and productive farm and forest land. The organization also owns preserves open to the public year-round for low-impact recreation.

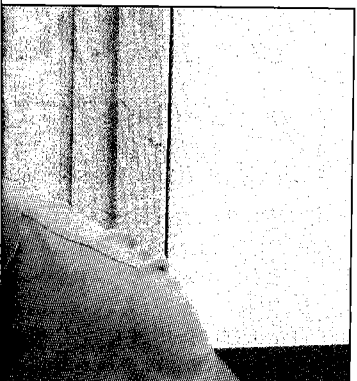

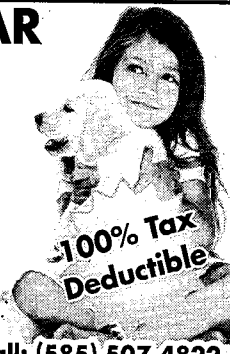
